UNITÀ FORMATIVA DISCIPLINARE N. 1: English main tenses + revision

Skills: be able to use the main tenses to speak about past experiences, present habits, recent events, future plans, hopes and desires

Vocabulary:

The house, the family, hobbies, relationships, routines, clothes, food, feelings (**Vocabulary Files 1, 2, 3, 4, 5**)

Grammar: Present simple vs present continuous; simple past, irregular verbs; past simple vs past continuous; present perfect vs past simple. Present perfect continuous. Used to do. Past perfect. Futures. If clause 1st type. (**Files 9, 10, 11, 17, 18, 19, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27 Grammar Book**)

UNITÀ FORMATIVA DISCIPLINARE N. 2: Introduction to THE WORLD OF TOURISM

Skills: be able to describe a picture
